1. Definitions

1. Cookies are information deposited and/or read on the terminal equipment (computer or smartphone) of equipment (computer or smartphone) of an Internet user (hereinafter referred to as ""User"") when consulting a website or when running a mobile application. They enable the collection and analysis of statistics on the use of websites and mobile applications and to store certain data on the User to facilitate his/her navigation (for example a session ID or the choice of a language).
2. Only the sender of a cookie can read or modify the information contained in it.
3. There are different types of cookies:
 - session cookies which disappear as soon as you leave the site;
 - permanent cookies that remain on your terminal until their lifetime expires or until you delete them using the functions of your browser.
4. You are informed that, during your visits to this site, cookies may be installed on your terminal equipment.

2. Purpose of the cookies used

5. The purpose of the cookies deposited during navigation on the RollingFunds site is to enable or facilitate electronic communication (detection of connection errors, identification of connection points, etc.).
6. Others are strictly necessary for the provision of online communication services at your express request (screen display preferences, etc.).
7. Others are used to analyse the number of visits to and use of the sites to improve the browsing experience; to improve the relevance of the advertisements displayed, so that they are adapted to the interests of the User, according to his choices; to make the sites more user-friendly and interactive.
8. The cookies used by RollingFunds can be distinguished into four distinct categories, namely:
 - Cookies needed for the operation of the sites

These cookies are necessary for the smooth operation of the sites, and are a prerequisite for the connection to the RollingFunds user account. These cookies do not include any personal data.
 - The cookies needed to personalize the operation of the sites

These cookies make it possible to remember the User's choices when browsing the sites to make their browsing more fluid.

- Identification cookies

Identification cookies are used in the context of registration and/or connection to the User's personal space. They allow the User to access his account and/or his space thanks to his identifiers and are necessary to authenticate the User. These cookies are limited to the connection session.

- Analytical cookies

These cookies are intended to measure and analyse the visits of the sites, the various sections, as well as the use of the services offered. They allow RollingFunds to improve the operation and ergonomics of the sites and services offered. The tools used are configured in such a way that RollingFunds only accesses anonymous data such as the number of visits, the number of pages consulted, the number of clicks, etc.

3. What cookies do we use?

9. The cookies used are placed by RollingFunds or third party cookies selected by RollingFunds to achieve specific objectives.

3.1. RollingFunds cookies

10. The cookies placed on the sites by RollingFunds' own tools are listed in the table below table below:

3.2. Third-party cookies

11. RollingFunds also uses services offered by third parties.

3.2.1. Audience Measurement

12. The Google Analytics service allows users to count visitors and to identify how they use the website. It is a statistical tool that allows RollingFunds to improve its websites by taking into account the needs of visitors

13. The data generated by these cookies relate to:

- your use of the site, such as the pages you have visited;
- your IP address to determine the city of connection. This data is immediately anonymised after localisation and is not communicated to Google.

14. The cookies used are detailed in the Google Analytics cookie policy accessible on the link <https://policies.google.com/technologies/types?hl=fr>

They enable the collection of statistical data about your use of the website, including the content you click on while browsing the site, to improve the performance and design of the website.

Cookies have a maximum lifetime of 13 months.

4. Consent band

15. On your first visit to the site, an information banner is displayed on the screen and offers you the opportunity to accept or refuse the use of certain cookies. By continuing to browse the site, you accept the use of cookies.

16. The deposit and reading of cookies can therefore not be carried out without your consent:

- If you access the site but do not continue your navigation, or if you do not close the window (information banner), a simple absence of action cannot be considered as an expression of will. This rule applies both when you go to the homepage of the site and when you access another page of the site from a search engine;
- if you click on one of the links in the banner, allowing you to better understand how cookies are used, to configure the settings and, if necessary, to refuse the installation of cookies.

17. If you do not wish to have cookies installed or read on your terminal equipment, a refusal cookie will be placed on your equipment, so that RollingFunds can record the information that you have objected to the use of cookies. If you delete this cookie, it will no longer be possible to identify you as having refused the use of cookies.

18. Similarly, when you accept the use of cookies, a consent cookie is set.

19. The consent or refusal cookies must remain on your terminal equipment. You can change your wishes at any time as indicated in the following section entitled "Cookie Management".

5. Cookie management

20. You have several options for deleting and managing cookies and other trackers.

5.1. Browser settings

21. While most browsers are set by default to accept the installation of cookies, you can, if you wish, choose to accept all cookies, reject them systematically or choose which ones you accept depending on their sender. You can also regularly delete cookies from your terminal via your browser.

22. However, do not forget to configure the settings of all the browsers on your various terminals (tablets, smartphones, computers).

23. For the management of cookies and your choices, the configuration of each browser is different. It is described in the help menu of your browser, which will allow you to know how to modify your wishes regarding cookies. As an example:

24. However, we would like to draw your attention to the fact that by setting your browser to refuse cookies, certain functions, pages and areas of the sites will not be accessible, for which RollingFunds cannot be held responsible.

5.2. Opposition modules from publisher

25. You can choose to disable certain third-party cookies, by going directly to the page of the issuer. For example:

5.3. Opposition platforms

26. Several platforms of advertising professionals also offer you the possibility to refuse or accept cookies used by their member companies. These centralised mechanisms do not block the display of advertisements, but only prevent the installation of cookies that allow advertisements to be tailored to your interests.

27. You can, for example, visit the site www.youronlinechoices.com to prevent the installation of these cookies on your terminal. This site is proposed by the digital advertising professionals grouped together within the European Digital Advertising Alliance (EDAA) and managed in France by the Interactive Advertising Bureau France.

28. You will be able to find out which companies are registered with this platform and which offer you the possibility of refusing or accepting the cookies used by these companies to adapt the advertisements likely to be displayed on your terminal to your browsing information: <http://www.youronlinechoices.com/fr/controler-ses-cookies/>.

29. This European platform is shared by hundreds of Internet advertising professionals and constitutes a centralised interface allowing you to express your refusal or acceptance of cookies likely to be used to adapt the advertisements likely to be displayed on your terminal to your navigation.

6. Protection of personal data

30. In the context of the use of cookies as described in this policy, RollingFunds will be likely to process personal data concerning you as the controller.

31. The collected data are indispensable to achieve the objectives pursued by each cookie.

32. The collected data may be transferred to a third party in compliance with the rules defined in the RollingFunds rules defined in the RollingFunds Personal Data Protection Policy, which can be consulted here [Personal data protection policy](#).

33. Personal data collected via cookies are never kept for longer than is necessary to achieve the purpose of the cookie, and in no case longer than 13 months.

35. The data collected is, after the death of the person, kept for the period necessary for RollingFunds to comply with its legal and regulatory obligations. At the end of this period, the data will be deleted, unless the person decides that it should be communicated to a third party of his/her choice, in accordance with the provisions of article 85 of the law n°78-17 of 6 January 1978 relating to data processing, files and freedoms.

37. In the event of a dispute, it is possible to refer the matter to the Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés, the competent supervisory authority.
